Dear Mr. Powers:

On September 12, 2011 the SVCC discussed an announcement by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) of a settlement agreement between the Los Angeles County District Attorney and SA Recycling, LLC with respect to a complaint of hazardous waste air pollution violations by the company at the Port of Los Angeles. Among the complaint's allegations was that of the illegal disposal of hazardous waste at the Simi Valley Landfill and Recycling Center.

Protecting the health and safety of the residents of Simi Valley is of paramount concern to the City Council. As such, and on behalf of the City Council, I request the County of Ventura provide the City a report of the matter and your conclusions as to the appropriate application of dust control and other measures at the Simi Valley Landfill to assure that public health has been properly safeguarded.
