

SUBJECT: IRS STATUS FOR DONATIONS TO THE SIMI VALLEY COUNCIL ON AGING

The Simi Valley Council On Aging (COA) was formed under the authority of the City Council and supports the Meals On Wheels, Lifeline, and Brown Bag programs. The funding for these programs is provided by fund raisers, as well as donations from individuals and businesses.

As a government agency, the COA does not have tax-exempt status. However, the City Attorney has verified that any contribution made to the COA is tax deductible per Internal Revenue Code Section 170. This section allows deductibility if the contribution is made to or for the use of the United States, state, local government, District of Columbia, or a U.S. possession, for exclusively public purposes. Donations to the Council On Aging, organized under the Simi Valley City Council, are for public purposes exclusively, and fall with the provisions of the foregoing code section. This letter is not intended to provide tax advice; please consult your tax advisor for specific guidance regarding your particular tax situation.
