25.	<u>ANNUAL CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) AND TIPPING FEE ADJUSTMENT</u>	

The rates in sections 1-12 and 18, above, shall be automatically adjusted to reflect changes in the CPI. The rates in sections 1, 2A, 3, 4, 6, and 8 above, shall be automatically adjusted to reflect changes in the landfill tipping fee. The adjustment shall be effective on the first day of January each calendar year. The CPI adjustment shall be equal to the amount derived by multiplying the previous rate times the percentage increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers within the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County metropolitan area during the prior calendar year, less shelter. The comparison shall be made as of September of each year and shall be effective each January 1st thereafter. For the purposes of determining annual adjustments in the landfill tipping fee portion of the rate adjustment formula, the tipping fee is comprised of the franchised hauler disposal rate, the Ventura County Integrated Waste Management Plan (CIWMP) fee, and the City's AB 939 fee. As of the effective date of this Exhibit, these fees are \$61.45/ton, \$.05/ton, and \$0.45/ton, respectively.

The formulas for the annual CPI and landfill tipping fee adjustments are as follows:

- (1) CPI Formula (sections 1-12 and 18): Rate x (86% x CPI)
- (2) Landfill Tipping Fee Formula:
 - (a) Residential Rate (sections 1, 2A, 3, and 4) - \$0.45 per \$1.00/ton landfill increase times current City published diversion rate, e.g., \$1.00 landfill increase with a 25% diversion rate would equal: $\$.45 \times 1 = \$.45 \times 25\% = \$.11$. $\$.45 - \$.11 = \$.34$ rate increase.
 - (b) Nonresidential Rate (sections 6 and 8) - \$0.90 per \$1.00/ton landfill increase times current City published diversion rate, e.g., \$1.00 landfill increase with a 25% diversion rate would equal: $\$.90 \times 1 = \$.90 \times 25\% = \$.23$. $\$.90 - \$.23 = \$.67$ rate increase.

26. EXTRAORDINARY COSTS

In addition to, and not in lieu of, the CPI and landfill adjustment, COLLECTOR shall also be entitled to rate increases or decreases in an amount equal to COLLECTOR'S extraordinary increases or decreases in its cost of collection. COLLECTOR'S IPC processing fees, now or later imposed, shall neither be levied on CITY nor added to the rates in Exhibit I. Such extraordinary increases or decreases in the cost of collection may include, by way of example and not by way of limitation: (1) a change in the location of the landfill or other lawful disposal sites to which the COLLECTOR is required to transport solid waste collected hereunder; (2) levied material recovery facility host fees; or (3) changes in the local, State or Federal laws governing temporary bin and roll off drop box services and collection, separation, transportation, recycling, composting, or disposal of solid waste and construction debris. Any additional special fees associated with special or mandated City programs in excess of those required in the Agreement shall be authorized by the City Council at a public hearing at which a supplemental rate adjustment shall be considered.

27. DELINQUENT ACCOUNT FEES

COLLECTOR may, in addition to a monthly charge for discards service, charge additional fees for accounts in arrears ninety (90) days or more, at which time the COLLECTOR may require a deposit from a customer equal to the cost of ninety (90) days of service before renewing or continuing to provide service. Such deposit shall be refundable and shall not replace or reduce any past due amounts or late charges owed which may be required to be paid in full at the same time a deposit is paid.

28. SENIOR CITIZEN RATE

The Senior Citizen Rate is for senior citizen heads of household, sixty-two (62) years of age and older.

29. UNAUTHORIZED SERVICES AND RATES

Services and rates not listed in this Exhibit shall be considered an unauthorized level of service and rate and shall not be provided or levied within the City limits of the City of Simi Valley. Any requests for extraordinary costs or additional rates or services shall be brought to the attention of the Director of Community Services for evaluation and disposition.
