



REQUEST FOR WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATION FACILITY FOR REVIEW PURSUANT TO SECTION 6409(a) OF THE MIDDLE-CLASS TAX RELIEF ACT

Modification of an existing, approved wireless telecommunication facility may be reviewed per Section 6409(a) of the Middle-Class Tax Relief Act if, following the completion of this request form and submittal of all items required herein, the City, upon review of this application, determines that the proposed modification meets the requirements of the subject Section.

REQUEST FOR REVIEW PER SECTION 6409(a) OF THE MIDDLE-CLASS TAX RELIEF ACT

As an FCC licensed telecommunications carrier, I request that the subject modification of an existing, approved telecommunications facility be reviewed pursuant to Section 6409(a) of the Middle-Class Tax Relief Act (hereafter referred to as Section 6409). I assert that:

- (1) The submitted materials show the modification to be an eligible facility modification,
- (2) Applications for all required permits are herewith submitted.
- (3) I independently **DO** _____ / **DO NOT** _____ **CHOOSE** to have the Building Permit construction review to be part of the 6409(a) review process (**INITIAL CHOICE**).

I recognize that, if the modification does not qualify for review per Section 6409, then the application(s) will be denied without prejudice, and an application for a standard modification may be immediately submitted per Simi Valley Municipal Code Section 5-35.01, et. seq.

ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION

The proposed modification must be found not to be a substantial change pursuant to FCC Rules, 47 C.F.R. sec. 140001(b)(7). Applicant must provide the following information as part of Section IV ("Summary of Items Required to be Submitted with an Application") of the Wireless Telecommunications Permit Application Packet.

INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Provide the entitlement number for the existing facility and evidence of City permits for all existing equipment.
2. Provide the change in physical dimensions of the proposed wireless tower, including antennas and antenna mounts, cables, and any camouflaging.
3. Show that the proposed number of equipment cabinets and existing cabinets will not exceed four (4) in total.
4. Show that all excavation and equipment deployed for the modification will not extend beyond the existing approved site.
5. Show all changes to the supporting tower or base station, and describe changes to the existing facility's camouflaging.
6. Show that the proposed modification will not defeat the purpose of approved camouflaging. Recognize that the purpose of camouflaging is for the telecommunications facility to seamlessly blend into the existing environment. Changes to: (1) base station architecture that reduce the architectural integration of the telecommunication facility with its surroundings, or (2) increasing the prominence of exposed DAS "pencil" antennas by replacement with panel antennas, would defeat the purpose of the approved camouflaging.
7. Complete the FCC "Optional Checklist for Local Government," for each frequency/band that will be used, to demonstrate compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 1.1307 et. seq.
