Tuesday and Thursday from 1:00 – 4:00 pm (excluding holidays)

Please call the property room at (805) 583-6964 to arrange an appointment or use the white phone located at the Property Window in the lobby of the department.

DO NOT LEAVE DRUGS AT THE WINDOW OR ON THE FLOOR.

How to dispose of unwanted medications:

- Empty the contents of pill bottles into a ziplock bag. (Please recycle pill bottles at home and scratch out all personal identification.)
- Leave liquids, gels or creams in their original containers and place them in a ziplock bag.
- Acceptable items to deposit are prescription medications and any over-the-counter pills, liquids and creams, any pet medications and nebulizer solutions.

Items not to be deposited:

- Intravenous solutions, IV bags, oxygen tanks, nebulizer machines, inhalers and thermometers.

How to dispose of sharps:

Such as needles, syringes and any other items used for diabetic tests. Sharps disposal containers are available for free from Sierra Vista Family Medical Clinic, located at 1227 E. Los Angeles Avenue, Simi Valley, CA 93065. (805) 582-4000
